## Call for Nominations

The purpose of this award is to recognize innovation and excellence in international trade curriculum development, research, program development, and/or advocacy of international business issues. NASBITE encourages the nomination of candidates who:

- Possess and exhibit professional skills that demonstrate comprehensive and current knowledge in the field
- Demonstrate unusual commitment to international trade education
- Have produced tangible outcomes such as curriculum products or services, or economic development programs
- Support innovative and creative approaches in their work
- Have made significant contributions to the field
