



Scholarships

Eligibility:

- **Students** - Must be a part-time or full-time student at a 2-year or 4-year institution of higher education, pursuing a business-related degree with coursework and/or related club/organizational engagement with and international trade or global business.
- **Faculty & Staff** - Currently employed part-time or full-time at a 2-year or 4-year institution and are involved in teaching or supporting international business/global trade/trade education courses or programmatic activities.
- **Other** – Individuals employed by a business engaged in international trade (importing & exporting) who have interest in enhancing their professional knowledge, skills and expertise in the field of global trade.

Use of Funds:

Scholarship requests may be used to fund one or more of the following resources provided by NASITE International

- Student Pathway Program Registration (\$75)
- CGBP Exam Fee (\$195 – as a Student Pathway member or \$395 regular rate)
- CGBP Practice Exam (\$50) *
- CGBP Exam Study Pack (\$199) *
- National Small Business Exporter Summit Registration (at rate posted)
- NASBITE International Conference Registration (as rate posted)
